We invite 6^{th} - 12^{th} grade students to display their artistic talents and enter the SEFH Poster Contest. The primary objective of this contest is to encourage students to develop creative visualizations that embodies STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering, and Mathematics).

Each year, three place awards in each division (senior or junior) and several honorable mention awards may be given. The award/gift cards will be presented at the SEFH Awards Ceremony. Posters that have been awarded will be displayed at Science and Engineering Fair.

Students are able to compete for the prizes below:

 $1^{\mbox{\scriptsize St}}$ Place: \$100.00 gift card and SEFH medallion

2nd Place: \$75.00 gift card and SEFH medallion

 3^{rd} Place: \$50.00 gift card and SEFH medallion (This award made not be given, depending on the

number of entrants.)

 $Honorable\ Mention: \$25.00\ gift\ card\ SEFH\ medallion\ (This\ award\ made\ not\ be\ given,\ depending$

on the number of entrants.)

Original Artwork: Should the artist want their original artwork returned to them, It will be the responsibility of the artist to arrange the delivery of said piece. SEFH will not cover the cost to return any artwork to the artist.

Use Rights:

Artists who submit their artwork to the Science and Engineering Fair of Houston (SEFH) for any competition and have any of their submitted artwork chosen for participation in that competition agree to the following.

- a) That SEFH be granted usage of the chosen artwork only for display, marketing and promotional purposes for that, and for any future SEFH event(s) and that usage of that image is limited to SEFH press releases, SEFH event presentations, SEFH articles, SEFH graphics, SEFH slide shows, SEFH presentations, SEFH event materials and for use on the SEFH website.
- b) The artist further agrees that SEFH can maintain an archive of the chosen artwork for the purpose of a historical documentation and as a record of past submissions. This archive will be available for public viewing.
- c) SEFH will credit each image, with their Artist Name.
- d) Otherwise, the Artist shall maintain all copyrights of any images that are submitted to SEFH.
- e) By entering this, you are granting SEFH a non-exclusive, perpetual license to reproduce images of your artwork for the purpose of advertising this competition and your work and as a result of this marketing, sales.

SEFH POSTER DESIGN CONTEST

Rules and Regulations


The major objective of the SEFH Poster Design Contest is to encourage students to think about science and engineering in an artistic way, and to create imaginative interpretations of the substance of science and engineering. Three place awards and several honorable mention awards are given each year. Posters that have placed 1^{st} – 3^{rd} will be displayed at the at the University of Houston main campus in the UH STEM Center as at the SEFH Awards Ceremony.

ELIGIBILITY

Students in grades 6 through 12 currently enrolled in public and non-public schools as full-time students, in the 23-county fair region, are eligible to enter. Each entering student may submit one self-made poster. There is no limit on the number of entries that can be submitted from a particular school.

POSTER SPECIFICATION

Media must consist of poster board and any combination of ink or paint. Pencil or charcoal is not allowed. The design must be ready for reproduction. No more than three colors may be used. Shades of black and gray count as a single color. White is not counted as a color and may also be used. Shades of any other color will count as multiple colors depending on the number of shades used. Poster size must be 14" x 22" with a 1" margin on each side. The size of the artwork will be contained within a 12" x 20" space; a vertical design is required using the 14" side as the base. The 1" margins are for printing purposes. Do NOT mat, mount, or frame the poster. The title, "The 65th Science and Engineering Fair of Houston" must appear on the poster. Designs with a lot of fine detail work should be avoided. Bold, simple designs are encouraged. The theme should symbolize the Fair as an aid to education and depict one or more areas of science, technology, engineering or mathematics.



JUDGING CRITERIA

Posters will be judged for creativity, scientific and technical accuracy, and artistic skill. All entries submitted must be **original**. **Copying is not acceptable**. Computer generated work is permissible, however, work copied from published photographs, magazines, book illustrations, other artwork or in likeness of published artwork cannot be submitted.

SUBMITTING ENTRIES

A completed copy of the entry form must be taped to the backside of the poster. All posters from a school should be enclosed in a single wrapping paper package and marked with the name of the teacher and school. It must be brought to either the Fair Office or mailed to SEFH Poster Contest, c/o University of Houston, STEM Center, 3585 Cullen Blvd., Lamar Fleming Bldg., Room 138, Houston, TX 77204. All entries must be received by the deadline date, visit sefhouston.org for more information. There is no entry fee.
