



## INFORMATION/CHECKLIST FOR STUDENTS ATTENDING SEFH

Assignment/Activity	Notes
1. Review the SEFH Calendar of Events with your parents/guardians for activities that occur each day of the fair.	
2. When you come to the Fort Bend Epic Center on Friday to register, you will have your	
project inspected for final approval by the Display & Safety (D&S) Committee.	
3. You may want to bring a comfortable folding chair (not a lounge-style chair) to have	
available at your project during non-judging times. Bring chairs Saturday morning. SEFH	
will not provide participants with chairs.	
4. When you setup your project display:	
Make certain that the number on your project display sticker matches the	
project number displayed at your project display area. If they don't match, you	
are in the wrong location (which you receive at the registration table). Ask for	
assistance if you cannot locate your assigned project display area.	
<ul> <li>Ensure that any of the following forms are showcased by your project if they</li> </ul>	
pertain to your research project: Official/stamped abstract from Scienteer, Form 1C	
if research institution/industrial setting used, Form 7 if it is a continuation project.	
5. Abstracts will be distributed at the event during check-in. Students will be given two (2)	
copies of their abstract, one affixed to their project area, the other to take home to make	
copies. Only the official abstract may be distributed at the fair.	
6. <b>Before</b> you leave the Fort Bend Epic Center on Friday, you <b>MUST</b> have your project	
approved by the D&S Committee. Failure to do so will result in a disqualification.	
7. On Saturday, " <b>Judging Day</b> ," please dress and groom yourself in an appropriate manner.	
Many professional scientists and engineers from the greater Houston area will judge you	
and your project. Clothing that is tattered, torn or may be deemed offensive is highly	
discouraged. You may want to have a light coat/jacket/sweater available since at times the Fort Bend Epic Center may be cold.	
8. Exhibitors must be at their project display during all judging periods. Your project will not	
be judged if you are not present. If you need to step away from your project, be sure to	
display the signage indicating you've stepped away. During judging times, only exhibitors,	
judges and SEFH personnel are allowed in the Judging Hall.	
9. Food service operations will be open on the day of judging. No commercial food deliveries	
are allowed on the judging floor. It is encouraged that Adult sponsors coordinate food	
deliveries for participants.	
10. First Aid will be on duty at all times during the check-in process and during the fair.	
11. The Fair is open for public viewing on Saturday between 4:30 PM - 6:30 PM (you are	
encouraged to be with your project all of this time). <b>Projects are to be dismantled and</b>	
removed from the display area at the conclusion of the Award Ceremony. All	
projects must be removed by 10:30 pm.	
12. Note that in addition to the approximately 200 SEFH place awards, about 50 Special	
Awarding Agencies present an additional 200 special awards each year.
